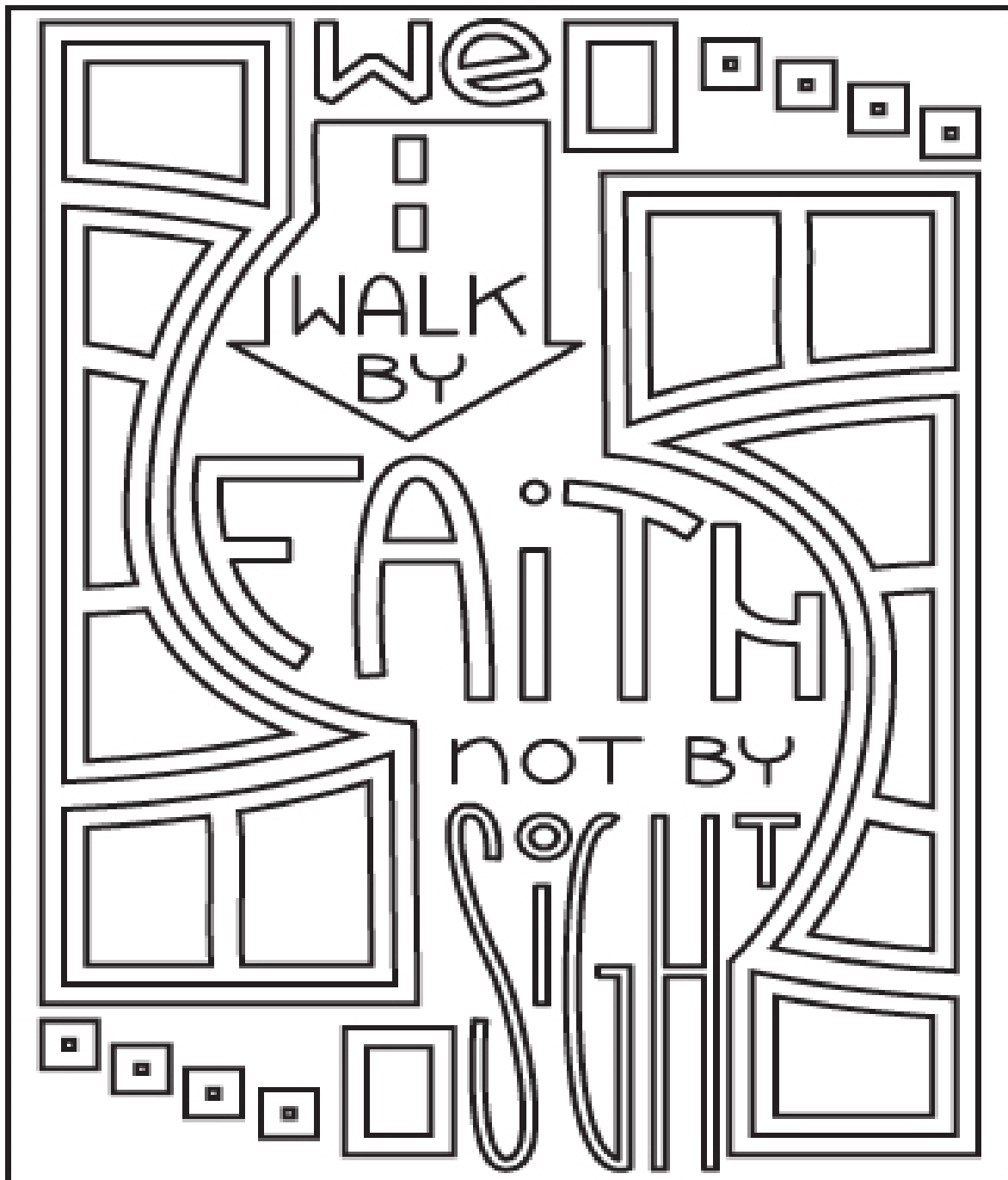

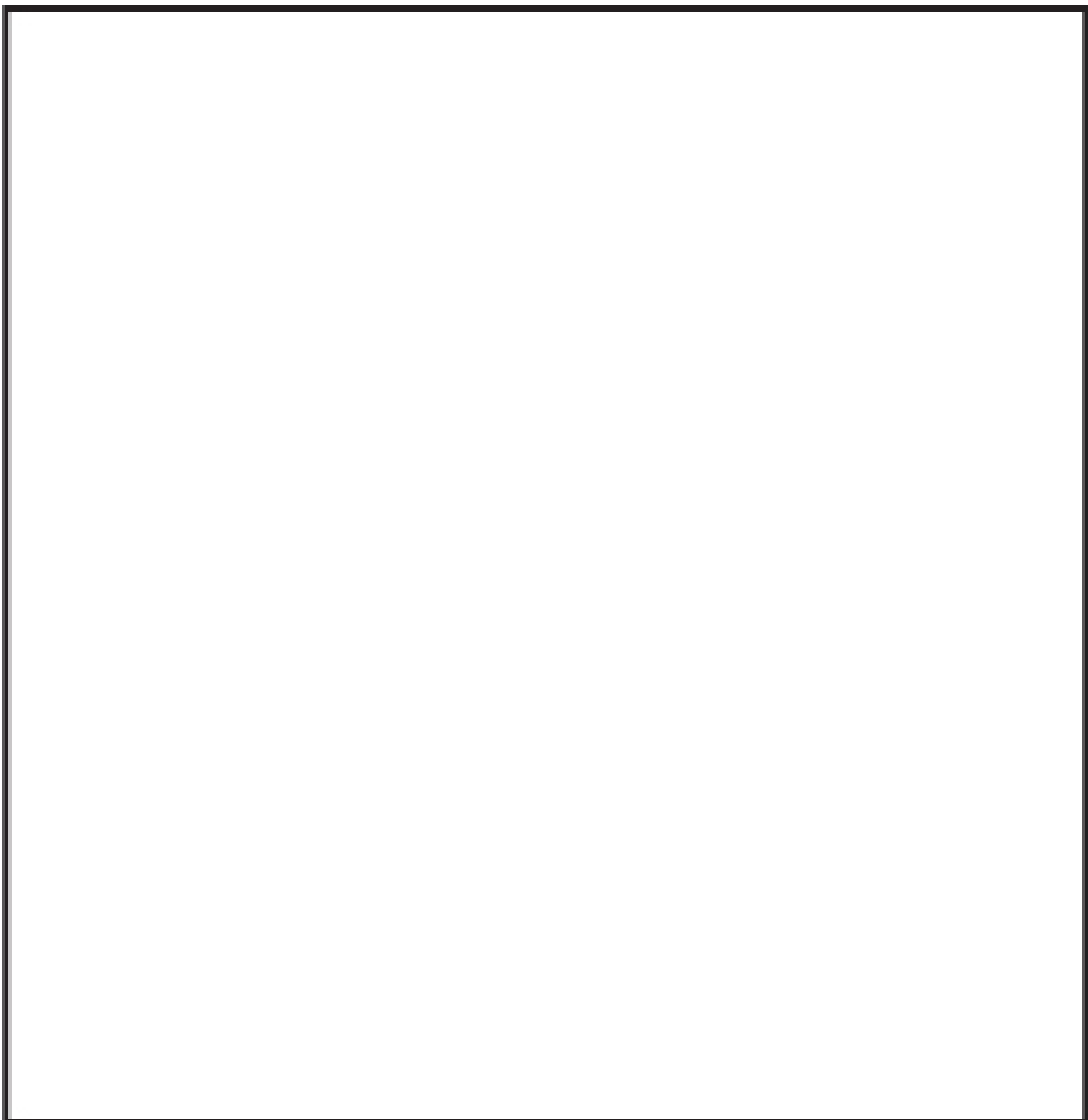
Activities based on 1 Samuel 15:34-16:13, Psalm 20,

# DRAW IT

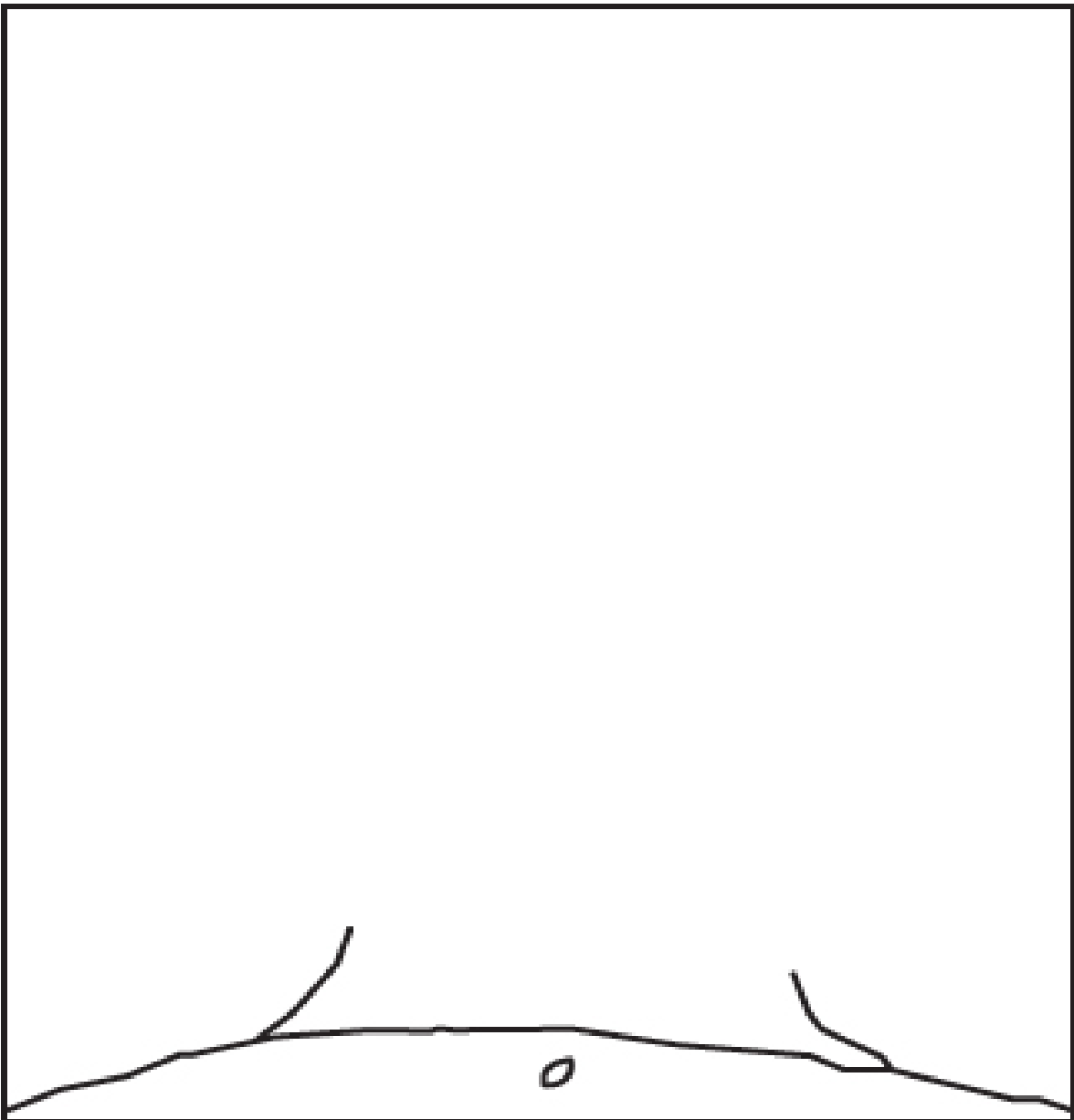

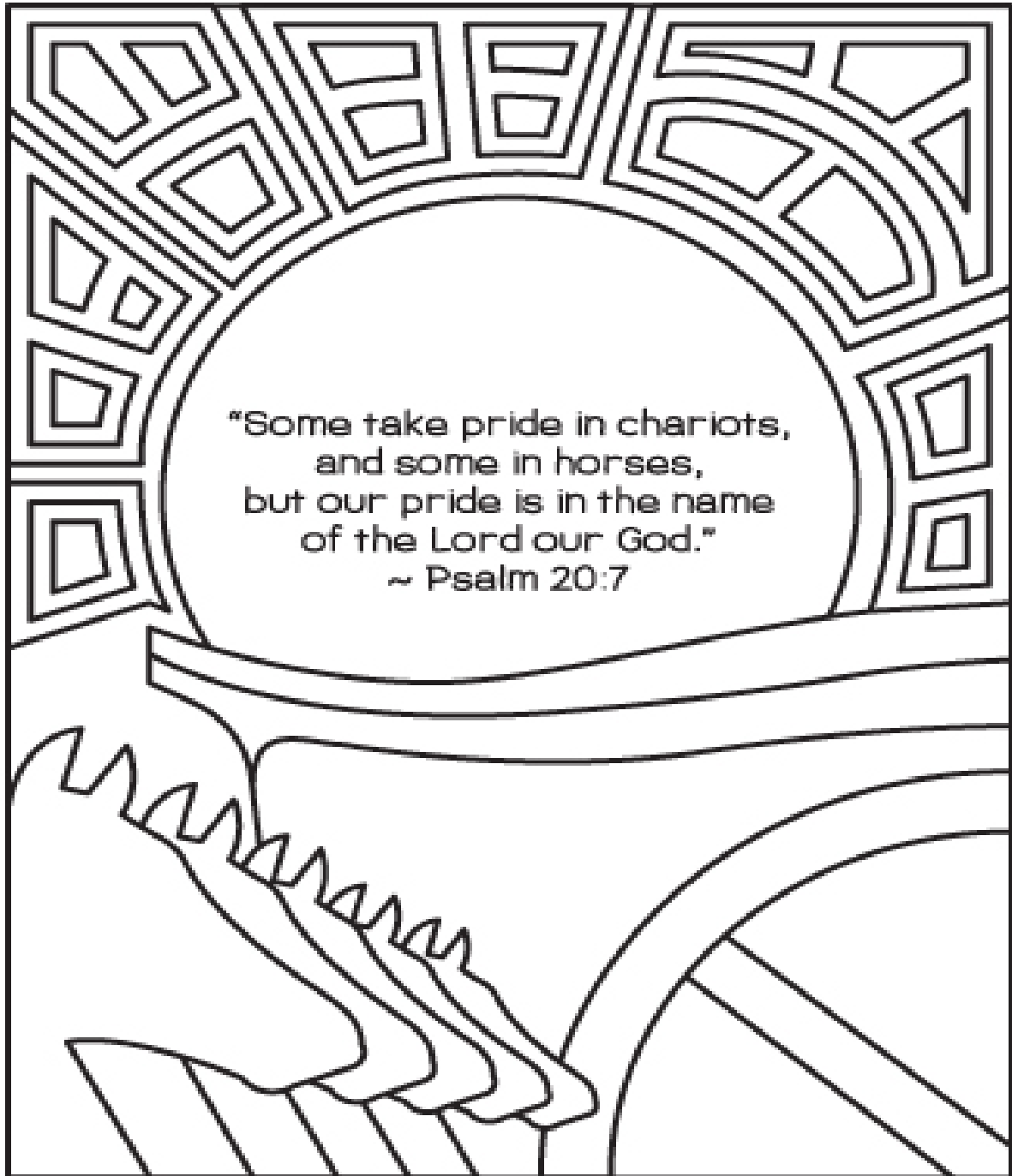


# FINISH the DRAWING
